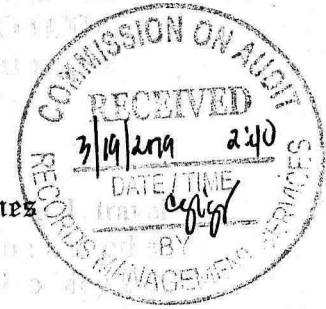

**SUBJECT: Amendment to COA Memorandum Nos. 2018-016 dated December 11, 2018 and 2019-003 dated February 7, 2019 on the conduct of the 2019 Nationwide Sports Competition of the COA Gender and Development (GAD) Focal Point (GFP) System for the 120<sup>th</sup> COA Anniversary Celebration**

In view of the forthcoming National Elections on May 13, 2019 and travel arrangement constraints, the conduct of the 2019 Nationwide Sports Competition and other activities to celebrate the 120<sup>th</sup> COA Anniversary is moved from May 6-10, 2019 to May 2-8, 2019. Accordingly, the schedule of activities under Item VII of COA Memorandum No. 2019-003 dated February 7, 2019 is hereby amended, as follows:

Activity	Date
1. Practice games for the Nationwide Sports Competition	5 days at 4 hours maximum per day within the month of March or April 2019
2. Submission to the Chair of the Committee on Sports and Physical Fitness the <b>certified list of winners</b> by the host regions of the Luzon, Visayas, and Mindanao Sports Competitions; and the <b>certified list of players</b> that shall constitute the line-up of players of the competing teams for Nationwide Sports Competition (except Basketball, Volleyball, Bowling and Chess which shall be based on selection) in accordance with the sports guidelines	Strictly within five (5) working days after the end of the respective sports competitions
3. Issuance by the COA Chair of the office order for the official players and participants to the Nationwide Sports Competition at the Central Office	On or before April 10, 2019
4. Arrival and check-in of official players and participants to the Nationwide Sports Competition	May 1, 2019*
5. Formal Opening of the Nationwide Sports Competition, and Welcome Dinner/Reception	May 2, 2019
6. Conduct of Nationwide Sports Competition	April 30 to May 7, 2019
7. Closing program and awarding of prizes for the winners of the Nationwide Sports Competition	May 8, 2019

\*Note: Except for Basketball and Volleyball Games which may start on April 30, 2019 due to the unavailability of the COA Sports and Cultural Center on May 6 and 7, 2019

Accordingly, the Committee on Sports and Physical Fitness shall issue the Amended Schedules of Games for the 2019 Nationwide Sports Competition.

All other provisions of COA Memorandum Nos. 2018-016 dated December 11, 2018 and 2019-003 dated February 7, 2019 not affected by the foregoing amendments shall remain in force.

The Chairperson of the Technical Working Group of the COA GPF System and Committee on Sports and Physical Fitness shall be responsible for the proper implementation of these guidelines.
