SUBJECT: Use of the enhanced Gender and Development Planning, Budgeting and Accomplishment Information System (GPBAIS)

Under COA Memorandum No. 2020-001 dated January 7, 2020, this Commission authorizes the use of GPBAIS for the online submission of the GAD Plan and Budget (GPB) and the GAD Accomplishment Report of the different committees of the COA GFP System in the Central Office and the GFP Sub-System (GFPSS) of all COA Regional Offices for Calendar Year (CY) 2020.

However, the GPBAIS has been enhanced to allow the system to consolidate the online submission of the different committees of the COA GFP System and the GFPSS. The enhanced GPBAIS now provides drop-down menus for Gender Issues, GAD mandate, Causes of Gender Issues, GAD Result Statement and Objectives, and Activities. These drop-down menus intend to facilitate the consolidation process and produce the annual COA GPBs and ARs for submission to the Philippine Commission on Women (PCW), through its Gender Mainstreaming Monitoring System (GMMS).

Accordingly, the enhanced GPBAIS shall be used in the annual preparation of the COA GPB and AR through the different committees of the COA GFP System and the GFPSS beginning CY 2021. The Committee on Finance and the Committee on Database and Website Development and Maintenance of the COA GFP System shall ensure the full operation of the enhanced GPBAIS. All concerns pertaining to the implementation of the system shall be addressed to these Committees.

The Technical Working Group, COA GFP System, shall conduct a virtual briefing on the enhanced GPBAIS to all the members of the COA GFP System and the GFPSS for information dissemination and immediate implementation of the system.
